

Randolph Township Trustees Budget Hearing Thursday, June 23, 2016

Chairman Sue White opened the hearing with the pledge at 7:00 p.m. Fiscal Officer Mary Rodenbucher explained how she arrived at the figures for the proposed 2017 budget. Mary stated as in the past the estimated revenue amounts are conservative. Included in the budget expenditures are a 5% increase for elected officials pay and a 10% increase for health insurance benefits. The health insurance benefit may be higher at renewal. The expenditures were increased by 3% in most funds. Mary stated that the state budget approved the local elected officials pay increase. There has been no pay increases for local elected officials since 2008. Mary recommended that we continue working to reduce expenses. Sue thanked Mary for working diligently on the township finances especially the General Fund.

Roger moved to accept the proposed 2017 Budget. Sue seconded. RCV: Roger – yes; John – yes; Sue – yes.

With no further questions, the budget hearing adjourned at 7:07 p.m.
